

If you're looking for an extra challenge, why not try baking bread in the shape of a partridge in a pear tree?







For an extra challenge, why not try crafting two turtle doves from marshmallows?





3 French Hens

Père-Noël Une bûche de Noël Bonne Année!









4 Colly Birds

Craft your own festive paper chains. Decorate your own, cut your strips from wrapping paper, or find some templates at: pawprintfamily.com/badgevent


For an extra challenge, why not race a friend or the clock to see how quickly you can make them?




6 Geese a-Laying

As a festive twist on a traditional egg and spoon race, pop your bauble on a spoon and hold it while you run.








7 Swans a-Swimming

You don't have to use cow's milk, why not see what you can make with an alternative type of milk?




9 Ladies Dancing

For an extra challenge, can you show off nine different dance moves? Why not try dancing to nine songs in a row?








10 Lords a-Leaping
