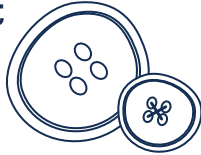


Butterfly Life Cycle

Follow the instructions below to create a 3D model of the butterfly life cycle.

1. Egg

Find an oval shaped bead or button to represent the egg.



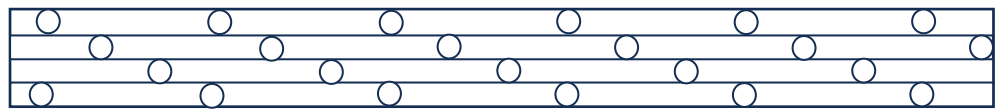
Did you know?

5 species of butterfly have become extinct in Britain in the last 150 years.



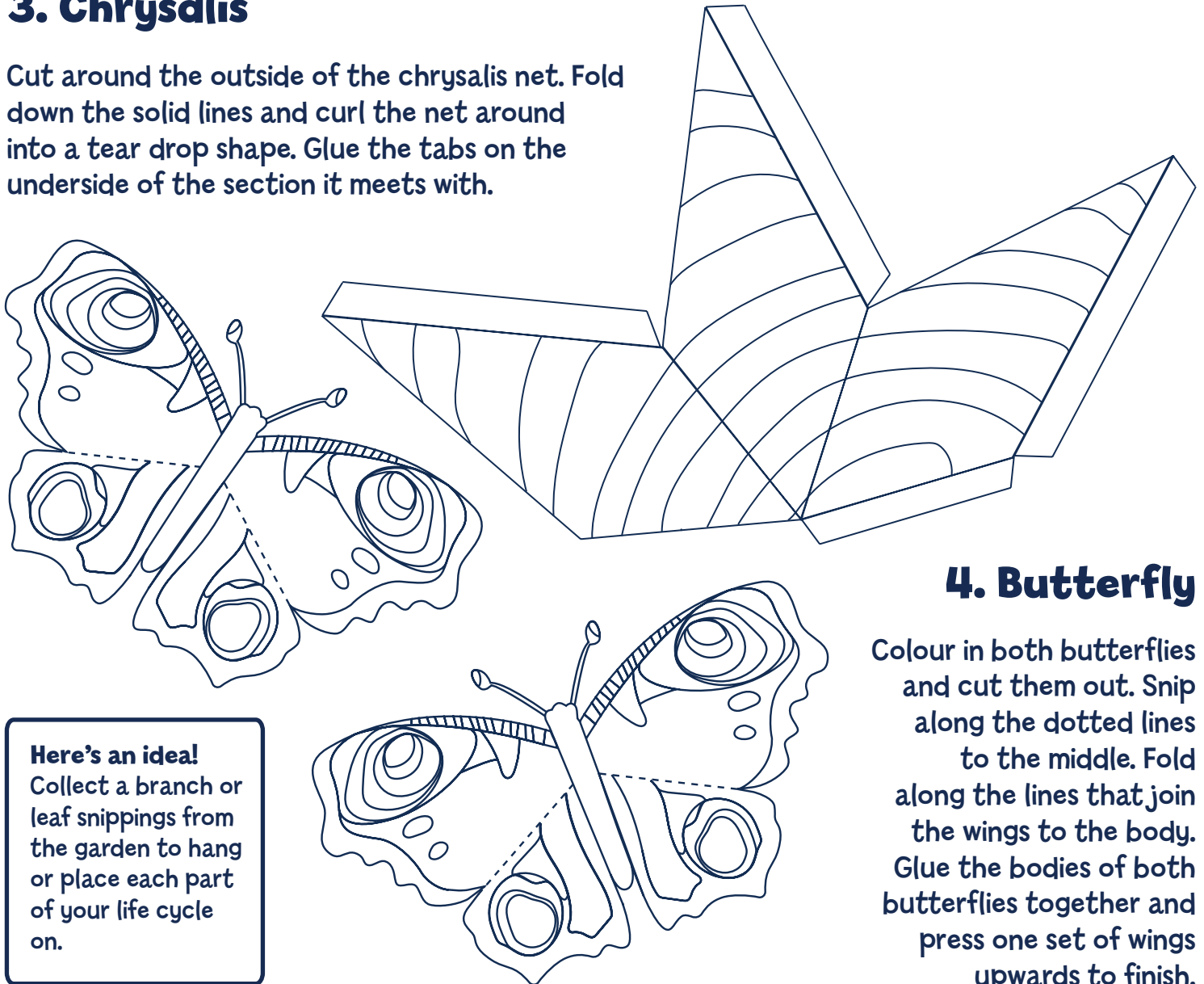
2. Caterpillar

Cut around the outside of the rectangle, colour in the stripes and spots, then curl the strip diagonally around a pencil to create a curly caterpillar.



3. Chrysalis

Cut around the outside of the chrysalis net. Fold down the solid lines and curl the net around into a tear drop shape. Glue the tabs on the underside of the section it meets with.



Here's an idea!

Collect a branch or leaf snippings from the garden to hang or place each part of your life cycle on.

4. Butterfly

Colour in both butterflies and cut them out. Snip along the dotted lines to the middle. Fold along the lines that join the wings to the body. Glue the bodies of both butterflies together and press one set of wings upwards to finish.
