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Craft

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BADGES**

-  Lambs are a popular spring symbol and an integral part of both Passover and Easter celebrations. Create a lamb puppet and use it to tell a story.
-  Make a hanging sheep/lamb decoration for an Easter tree.
-  Create a set of napkin holders from toilet rolls that look like lambs.
-  Have a go at spinning wool using a drop spindle. You can make a drop spindle from an old CD, a pencil and a screw hook. Check out our Pinterest board for some ideas.
-  Craft with wool.
-  Weave your own Easter eggs using wool/yarn, check out our Pinterest board for some ideas.
-  Make a pine cone sheep to decorate your home this spring.







Food

-  Bake sheep biscuits and decorate with coconut to make them look fuzzy.
-  Learn how to prepare and cook a leg of lamb for a roast dinner.

Why?




The lamb was a sacrifice made during the Jewish Passover and roasted lamb shanks are an important part of the Passover seder plate. Roasted leg of lamb is popular for Easter in many Christian countries as Jesus is referred to as the "Lamb of God" in the Bible.

-  Make your own Osterlamm (Easter Lamb) cake from Germany.
-  Cook a traditional shepherd's pie or lamb hot pot.
-  Bake your own lamb cupcakes and decorate with mini marshmallows.
-  Create an edible lamb picture giving your Easter lamb a fluffy popcorn fleece!





Games

PAWPRINT

-  Use a shepherd's crook to guide your balloon sheep through an obstacle course and get them safely home.
-  Make an A-Z of items you might see at Easter.
-  Round up your sheep!







How?

Using balloons, draw lamb heads on one side in permanent marker. In teams or individually, see how quickly you can 'round up your sheep' and get them in a pen (made from chairs or a clothes airer). Make it more challenging by not using your hands/feet.

-  Play a game of Easter roll and cover using our free resource.
-  Sheep can recognise their lambs by their bleats alone. Can you recognise people by their bleats? Make sheep noises and play guess who!



Other

-  Visit a farm at lambing time or see how lambs are cared for if/when they're rejected by their mothers.
-  Sing *Baa Baa Black Sheep* or another sheep based song. Can you write your own?
-  Put a spring in your step and take a walk to see if you can spot any new lambs in the fields.
-  Discover the differences in wool between different breeds of sheep. Compare and see which wools are best for different products depending on their qualities.
-  Watch sheep shearing and discover some of the uses for wool.
-  Take a trip to your local butchers to find out where the different cuts of lamb come from and what the difference is between lamb and mutton.
