My Emergency Card Template

You will need:

- 1. A copy of this sheet per person
- 2. Lightweight card
- 3. A pen/pencil each
- 4. Coloured pens/pencils to decorate
- 5. Scissors
- 6. Craft knife and cutting mat (optional)

To make your Emergency Card:

- 1. Print this sheet on to lightweight card, one copy each
- 2. Fill out your information on the dotted lines
- 3. Cut out along the heavier line around the edge of your emergency card.
- 4. Cut along the solid line in the Allergies section to create a slit, using a craft knife if you prefer.
- 5. From the bottom fold in a concertina until the Allergies section, creating a mountain fold (to the back) along the dot dash line and valleys (fold to the front) along the dashed lines.
- 6. Fold your details and the top flap around the edge and slot the tab through the slit you cut in the Allergies section to hold it all together.
- 7. Decorate the front, you can make it look like a first aid kit or just decorate it with your favourite colours and patterns.
- 8. Keep your Emergency Card in your bag or coat pocket so you have it with you in case of emergency.
