Grow your own Good Deed Tree and grow as an individual too.

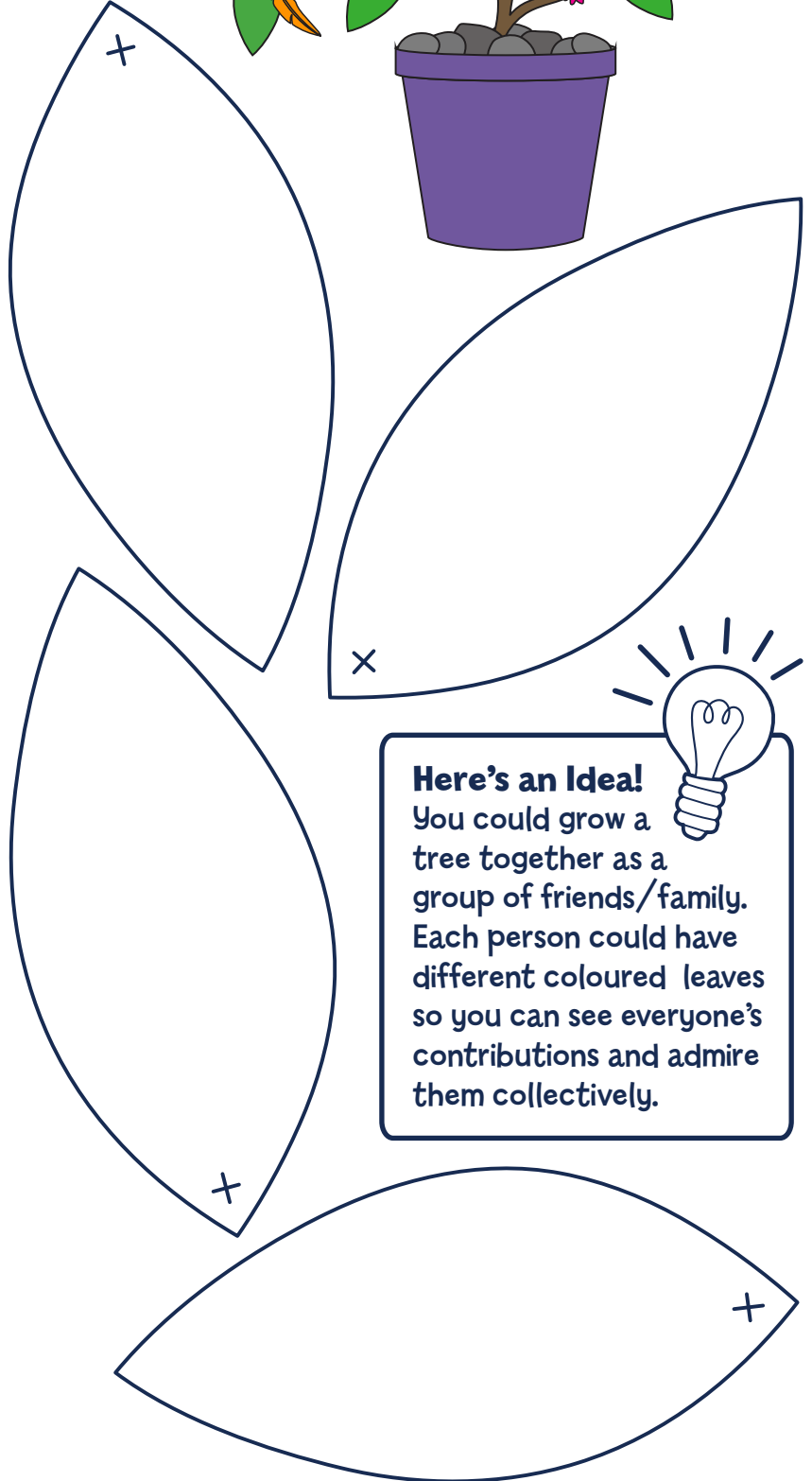
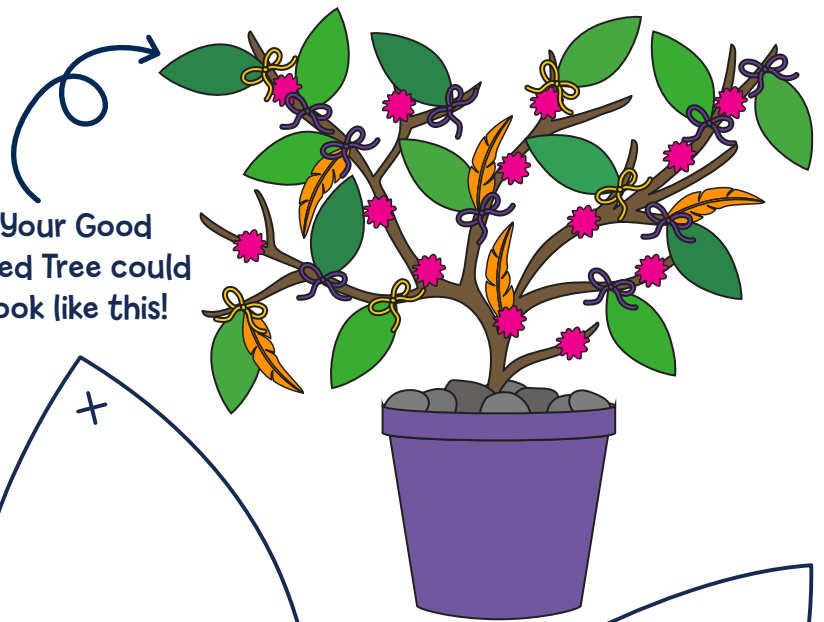
What You Need:

- A plant pot
- A small branch
- Pebbles or stones
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- String/ribbon
- A copy of this resource printed on to thin card/thin card in various colours
- Decorations: paint, feathers, pompoms, coloured yarn or ribbons (optional)

To Make Your Tree:

1. Place your branch in your plant pot and secure with pebbles to stop it falling over or wobbling around.
2. (Optional) Decorate your branch, wrapping coloured yarns/ribbons around it and adding pompoms/feathers, etc.
3. Cut out the leaves from this resource or create your own leaf shapes from thin card.
4. Hole punch each leaf at one end and thread through a short length of string/ribbon.
5. Write on a leaf each time you do a good deed (at the end of each day is a nice time to reflect).
6. Tie/hang your leaves on your branch and watch your Good Deed tree bloom!
