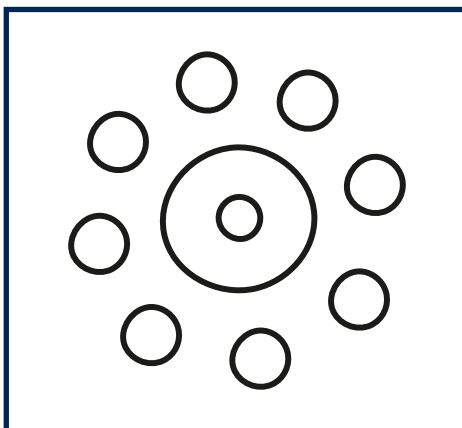


Iron Age Coin Symbol Meanings

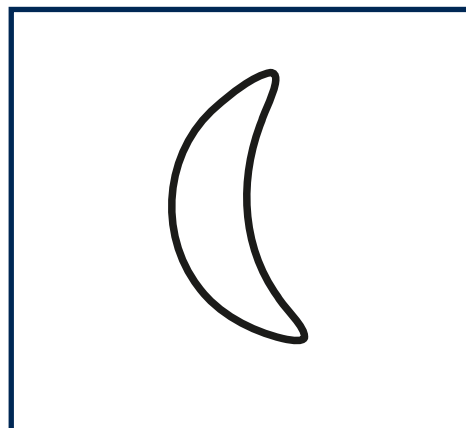

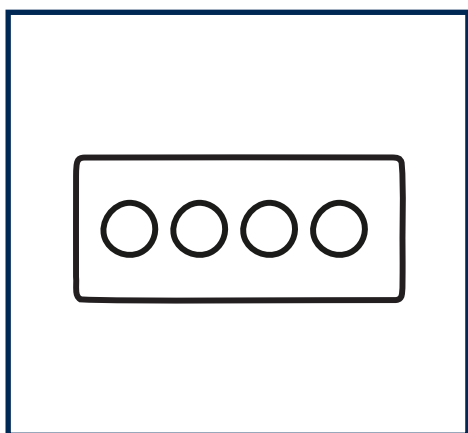
Horse:
Bravery and Strength



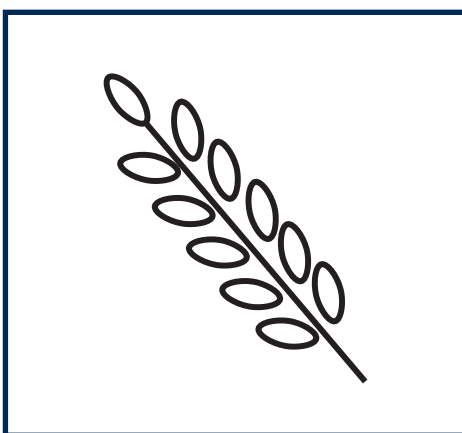
Sun Wheel:

Lunar Cycles



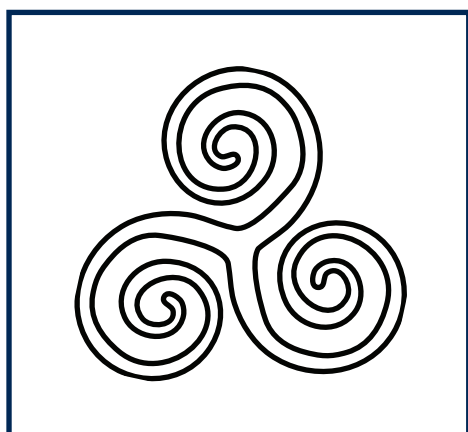
Domino:
Seeds in Soil



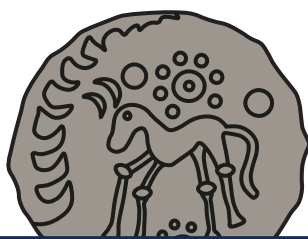
Ear of Barley:

Here's an Idea!

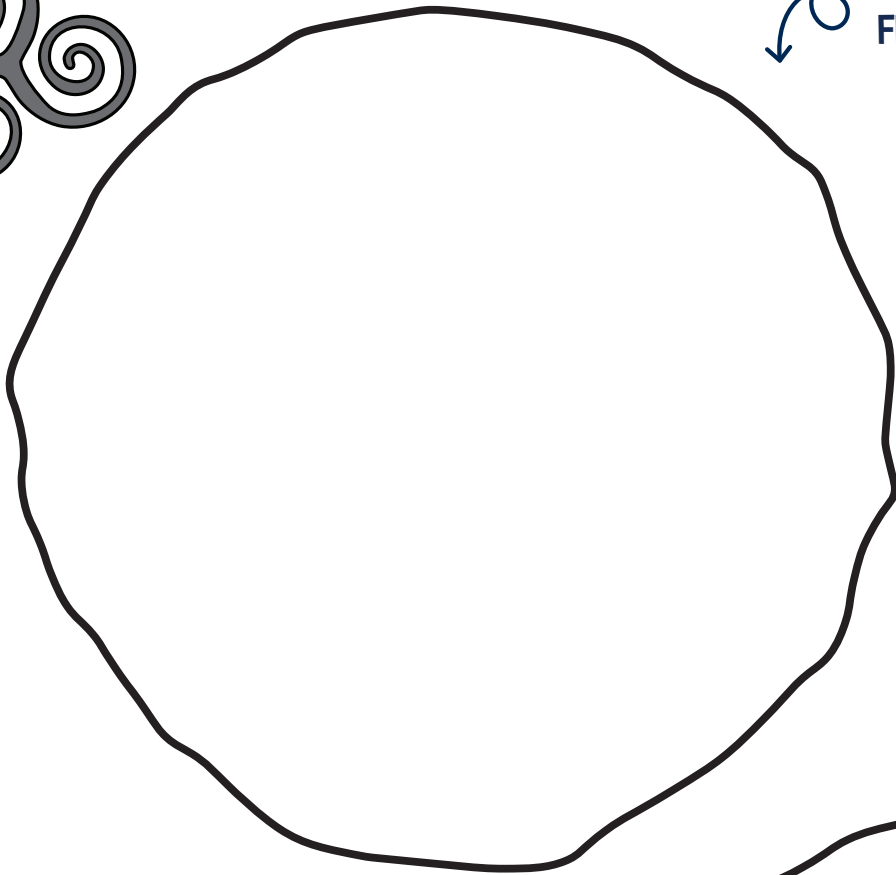
Why not take inspiration from your own life and family when designing your coin? You could include something special to you - like a pet or family symbol.
