

Jumping Frogs Puzzle

Can you solve this classic jumping frogs puzzle? Cut out the frogs at the bottom of the page and move them along the lily pads to find the solution!

Instructions

- Firstly, the frogs can only hop in the direction they are facing.
- There can only be one frog per lily pad.
- Frogs can only hop forwards one space, or two if they're leaping over another frog.
- The puzzle is solved when the two groups of frogs have swapped positions.
