You will need:

- · Cards (see following pages)
- Printer
- · Thin card or paper
- Scissors
- · Colouring pens/pencils
- Laminator (optional)
- Glue
- · Cereal box/similar

To Make Your Cards:

- 1. Print your chosen set of cards on to thin card or print on to paper and glue on to cereal box for strength.
- 2. Laminate (optional) to protect them so they can be reused.
- 3. Cut the cards out.
- 4. Repeat for the number of teams you have to create one set per group.

There are several ways to play with your orchestra cards, here are a couple of options for you.

Option 1 (ideal for individuals):

- Hide the cards around the space so they have to be found first.
- Race against the clock to put the cards together correctly.


Option 2 (perfect for large groups):

- Lay your cards out upside down at one end of the room. Mix sets to make it more challenging.
- Relay race to gather cards and put them together as quickly as you can.

Fancy an added challenge?


- Use the black and white set and draw pictures of the instruments on each card or have a go at making your own set.
