


Owl and the Pussycat Masks - Page 1


Use the masks below to re-tell or act out the well-known poem, 'The Owl and the Pussycat'!

Method:

1. Print on card and cut out the masks and the eye holes (the dashed lines).
2. Poke a pencil through the white holes on either side.
3. Measure from your left temple, around the back of your head, to your right temple, with a piece of string and cut it to that length.
4. Tie the string through the front of the left hole, around the back, and through the front of the right hole.

Don't forget to cut out the eye holes!


Here's an Idea!
