## Bonfire Night

## Paper Catherine Wheel

### You will need:

- Template (see following pages)
- Printer
- Black paper/card
- Scissors
- Drawing pin
- Sequins/glitter
- Metallic pens/paint
- Felt tips/colouring pens
- Wooden dowl/pencil
- Sticky tack

### Age 5-7:

Use the template provided and decorate with glitter, sequins, etc.

### Age 7-11:

Choose between the template provided and making your own.

### Age 11+:

Have a go at making your own template from a pentagon, hexagon, etc.

## To Make Your Catherine Wheel:

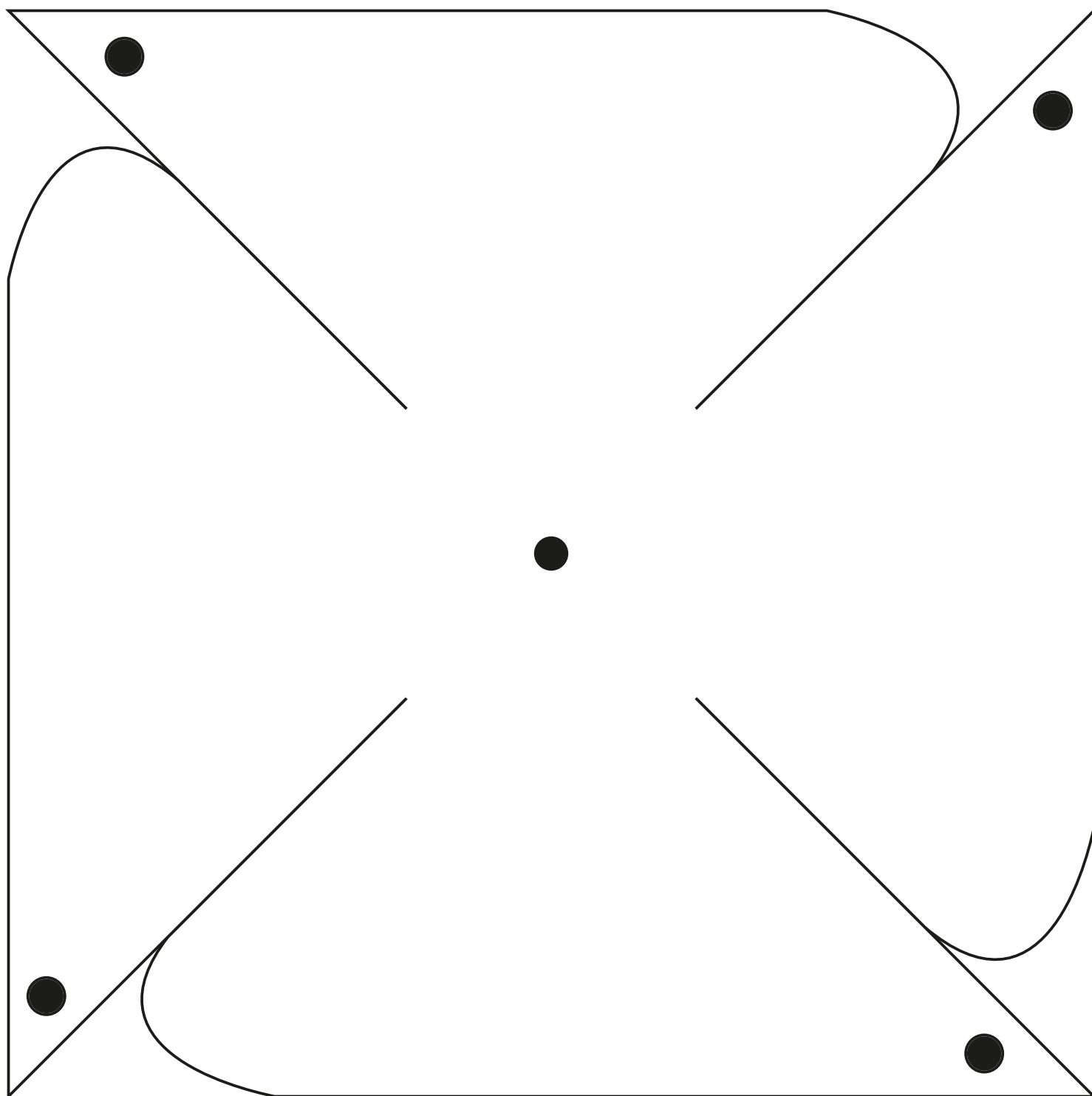
1. Cut out the template along the solid black lines.
2. Trace the template on to black paper if you want a night sky effect or alternatively decorate it with any materials you like.

(If you're using paint you'll need to use a thicker paper or card for your Catherine wheel so it doesn't go soggy!)

3. Decorate both sides with glitter, sequins and metallic paint/pens.
4. Fold the circles at the end of each point in to meet the circle in the centre.
5. Push the drawing pin through the 5 layers taking care not to hurt yourself.
6. Push the pin in to the end of the wooden dowl/pencil. Don't push it too far otherwise your Catherine wheel won't spin.
7. Make sure the pin isn't poking out of the other side of the dowl/pencil, if it is cover it with some sticky tack.
8. Blow your Catherine wheel round and watch it glitter and sparkle in the light.
