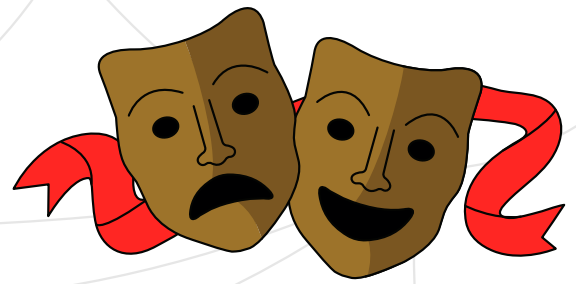


Pick a Performance

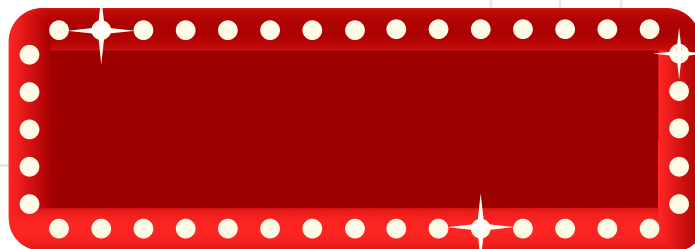
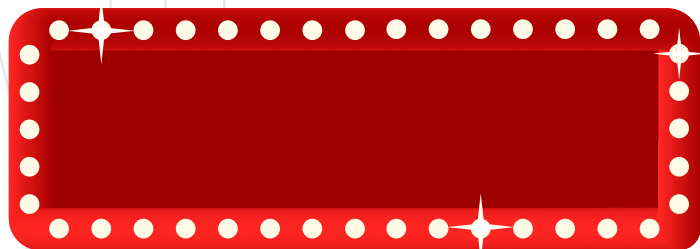
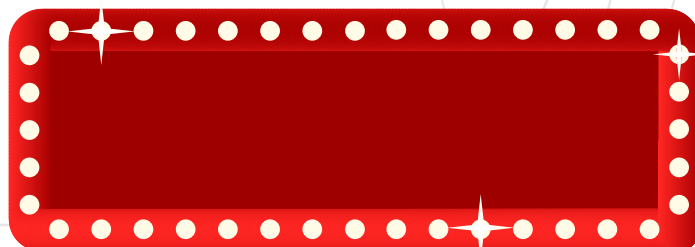
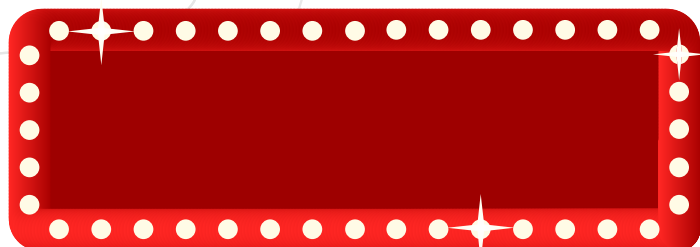
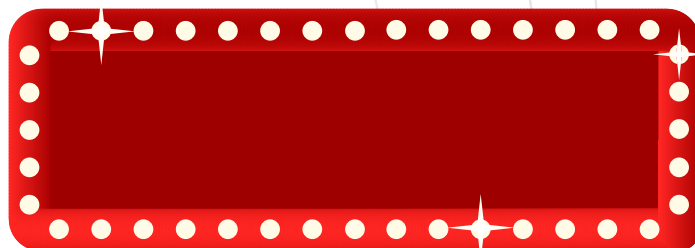
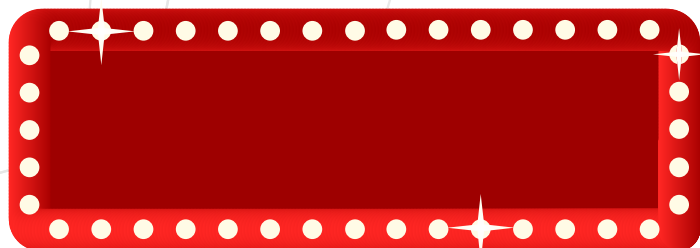
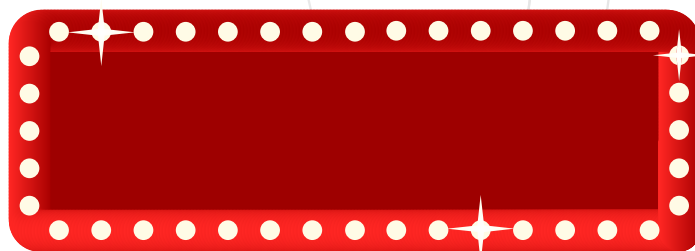
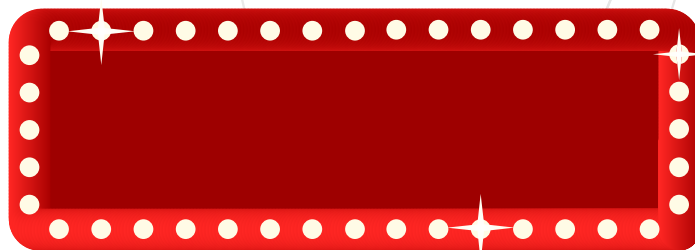
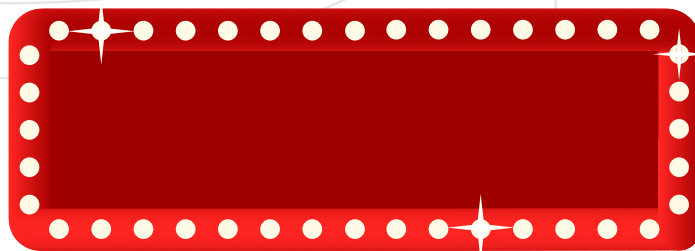
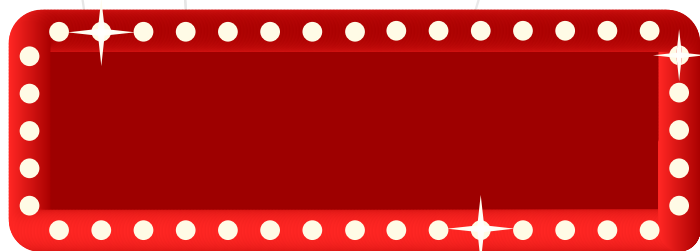
Pick a Performance - Page 2
