




# HOW TO: Use Your Challenge Pack

# & Craft

## PAWPRINT BADGES

**XX** Build a boat or raft, big or small and see if it floats.

#### Here's an idea!

You could use cardboard to make a canoe and try it out at your local sailing club/activity centre or craft foam and straws - you decide!

- Make your own pirate fancy dress.
- Create your own treasure chest.

#### Here's an Idea!

Why not use your treasure chest as a 'memories box' to treasure all your most important things. Recycled egg boxes or tea bag boxes make great treasure chests or you can buy ready to go chests from craft supply shops. Get creative and decorate your treasure chests - the more imaginative the better, wood effect is so last year!

- Design and create a pirate flag for your ship.
- **Make** a working compass.
- **to** Build a shelter.

#### Why?

Imagine you are deserted on a dessert island. You need to find shelter but there's nothing around, all you have are a few basic supplies and things that you've found to create a shelter for the night.

- 🧰 Make a working weather vane.
- **x** Write a message to your future self and seal it in a bottle.
- create your own knotted net or make something small using knots.
- Make a solar powered gadget to help you survive on your desert island.
- Decorate a pirate bandana.
- Use a party cup and tin foil to make your very own Captain Hook pirate hook. Imagine a gruesome pirate tale for how you lost your hand.
- Pretty Polly! Make a parrot for your shoulder from an old toilet roll tube or similar. Decorate with colourful feathers.

# 1 Food



- Decorate gingerbread men to look like pirates. You can eat one leg while no one is watching!
- 💢 Find out what kinds of food sailors/pirates would have eaten and why.
- 💢 Have a go at some survival cooking- prepare and cook rabbit or game birds.
- Learn about foraging, have a go and try cooking a meal using only the things you have found.

#### Remember!

There are lots of poisonous and dangerous foods out there so make sure to seek professional guidance and only cook and eat things you know are safe. If you're at all unsure, better safe than sorry!

- Many pirates and sailors suffered from scurvy, find out what that is and cook/prepare a meal that would help prevent it.
- Make foody ships/boats. Apple slices make great boats and cheese slices great sails!
- Create your own dessert islands.

#### What?

No, that wasn't a spelling mistake! Make your own sweet desert islands. Whether they have digestive biscuit sand or marshmallow palm trees make them as creative as you can and don't forget all those sea creatures and birds of paradise that may be lurking!

- Fresh fish was often caught at sea as fresh protein for pirates and sailors.

  Prepare a dish using fresh fish. Why not have a go at catching your own too?
- Make your own non-alcoholic grog.
- Salted meats were popular among pirates, find out why and try some for yourself, what did you think?
- If you were deserted on a desert island and you could have one last meal of your choosing flown in to you, what would you choose and why? Why not cook/make it for your friends and family to try?!
- Use BBQ skewers and make some fruit or veg kebab swords. A great activity for developing knife skills in younger adventurers too!





Have a game of 'Pirates'.

#### How?

The group spread out, you need one caller. The caller shouts out an action or phrase that all must do. The last one to complete the action/the odd ones out are out of the game.

Actions are as follows (add any others you know):

Captain's coming = salute hand to your right eye brow

Scrub the decks = get down on hands and knees and pretend to scrub

Climb the rigging = move hands and feet as though climbing a ladder

Captain's wife = pretend to raise skirt and wolf whistle

Life boats in 2/3/4 = get into groups of the specified number

Port = run to the left

Starboard = run to the right

- Find the treasure in the sand. Bran tub style, find the pieces of eight in the sand box.
- Ship attack. Water bomb ship targets a great game for hot weather.
- Pin the eye patch on the pirate. Just make sure it's not a real person otherwise they may end up needing an eye patch!
- Hold a scavenger hunt. Find the keys to unlock the treasure chest.
- Walk the plank.

#### How?

Get your team from one end of the room to the other using only 2 planks and 2 crates. Remember if your feet touch the floor you'll be condemned to Davy Jones Locker forever (out of the game) and your team must start again.

### Message in a bottle.

#### How?

Prepare a number of bottles, each containing a sheet of paper with 3 random letters on it. Groups must select 3 bottles and make as many words as possible using their letters in a set amount of time.

- Play life size battle ships.
- Have a Captain Hook ring toss. Can you throw hoops on to Captain Hook's hook? Score points for the number of hoops.

# © Other



Put together a survival kit.

#### Why?

There has been a mutiny on your ship and your crew have left you for dead on a desert island in the middle of the ocean. Before they abandon you, you have the chance to gather together some things to help you survive on the island.

- Create your own pirate name and use it for the day. Use our Pirate Name Generator resource to help you.
- Enjoy a pirate themed film party. There are lots of swashbuckling tails of the high seas to pick from, both new and old! Why not enjoy some pirate themed food while you watch?
- You are marooned on an island and you can have 5 things from home, what do you choose and why? Are your choices different to other people's? Why do you think this is?
- Pirates hunted treasure and gold. Raise money for your group or a good cause and gather your own pieces of eight!
- Learn how to signal to other boats using Semaphore flag signals or flash light Morse code.

#### Here's an idea!

Why not see if you can send secret messages to one another using only signals, no words allowed! Did you decipher the messages correctly?

- 💢 Learn to speak like a pirate and celebrate Talk Like a Pirate Day.
- Visit your local sailing club and try your hand at sailing.
- Find out about some famous pirates. Why were they famous?
- Invite someone to teach you about survival skills. Fancy developing your survival skills even more? Why not complete your Castaway Adventures challenge?
- Put on a play about pirates or visit the theatre to see a pirate or gang show.
- Discover the real name for the skull and cross bones flag and find out how ships identify themselves at sea.
