

# Resource Badgevent Calendar: Pop-Up Monster

### You will need:

- · Badgevent Calendar box
- Monster body parts
- Printer
- · Thin card or plain paper
- Scissors
- Colouring pens/pencils
- Paint (optional)
- Glue/double sided tape

### **Grown-Ups:**

Use this resource to transform your Badgevent Calendar box in to a pop-up monster.

#### Why not make it in to a Worry Monster?

Get your young person to write down what's worrying them and feed it to your Worry Monster. Sometimes telling a Worry Monster is easier than telling a grown-up. Afterwards you can discuss together.


### Instructions:

#### To make your pop-up monster:

- 1. Print the following pages on to plain paper.
- 2. Colour in and decorate your chosen body parts with any materials you like.
- 3. Wrap your box with the front, back and side pieces (see detailed instructions on the following pages).
- 4. Add feet (if using).
- 5. Pull out the draw and add your insert with the top of the face at the end of the draw with the ribbon pull.
- 6. Add your tongue and eyes to your monster face and re-insert the draw (see detailed instructions on the following pages).
- 7. Add any other features; arms, legs, horns, hair to the outside of your box.
- 8. Pop-up your monster!!








#### To make your monster body:

#### Body - Blank Sides

Decorate only this side of your body parts. Create your own monster body with these blank templates.

What will your monster look like?

Cut to size along the dotted line. Print at 100% to fit your Badgevent Calendar box perfectly! Glue to back, left side of back pane Glue to back, right side of back panel Glue to back, left side of front pane to back,

#### To make your monster body:

- 1. Cut out the 4 body panels along the dashed lines. — — — —

#### Here's An Idea!

Why not fold some paper springs and stick them on the back of your chosen eyes so they pop out even more when your box is opened?!

#### Here's how:

- 1. Cut 2 lengths of paper or card approximately 1.5cm wide and 20cm long.
- 2. Stick the ends together at right angles.
- 3. Fold the bottom strip over the top strip, keeping them at right angles.
- 4. Repeat, folding each strip of paper alternately.
- 5. Secure the ends with glue or double sided to stop your spring unravelling.
- 6. Stick one end to your chosen monster body part and the other to the box!



### Templates Horns & Feet


Unless otherwise stated decorate only this side of your chosen body parts. Colour in your chosen feet and horns with any materials you choose and cut them out.





## Templates Tongues & Hair

Unless otherwise stated decorate only this side of your chosen body parts. Colour in your chosen tongue and any hair with any materials you choose and cut them out.



# **Templates**Eyes

Unless otherwise stated decorate only this side of your chosen body parts. Colour in as many eyes as you would like with any materials you choose and cut them out.
