

- 🔼 Make a sand art picture using coloured sand or salt.
- Create your own hand puppets like Punch and Judy. Why not put on a show for your Other challenge?
- Build a penny push arcade game of your own.
- Put together a sign about taking rubbish home and keeping beaches tidy.

Why?

At the end of 2023, it was found that over 480,000 pieces of rubbish had been removed from UK beaches. Not only does this make our beaches look messy, but it can also have a devastating impact on sea life.

- Paint a beach hut picture.
- Make some jewelery from sea glass or shells.
- Visit the beach and create a picture or craft a mobile using the items you have found.
- Southend is home to the world's longest pier, stretching for a whopping 1.33 miles! Build the longest pier you can from lolly sticks.
- 🚜 Build a sandcastle.
- Design and make your own kite. You can find tutorials on our 'Seaside' Pinterest board to help you to do this.
- oul>Use a beach ball to create a painting.

How?

A beach ball painting can be done in a very similar way to marble painting but bigger. First, prepare some deep trays with different coloured paint. Take it in turns to roll your beach ball in the different trays before rolling it around your paper or card. This will create a beautiful and unique effect.

- Sandwiches are a staple of a British seaside picnic! Craft some sandwiches out of different coloured card - what ingredients can you make?
- 🧚 Whip up some sand slime.
- Craft your favourite ice cream or ice lolly using coloured card and lolly sticks.

O Food

- Whip up your own ice cream or ice lollies.
- Make some starfish sandwiches.

How?

Make a sandwich as you normally would, using all of your favourite ingredients. Then use a star shaped cookie cutter to cut out as many starfish as you would like. You could even explore different cookie cutters and create your very own ocean of sandwich sea creatures!

- own doughnuts.
- Make candy floss.
- Seafood such as prawns, cockles and mussels are a popular snacks near the beach in the UK. Taste test different kinds of seafood.
- Have a go at frying your own fish and chips.

Here's an idea!

Transport yourself back to the 1980s and wrap your fish and chips in paper. You could use greaseproof paper or even paper party bags. This would be a perfect idea to serve at a seaside themed party for family and friends.

- Make your own 99 ice creams and find out the reason behind the name 99.
- Bake some RNLI boat biscuits or make some edible boats.
- 🧚 Mold your own chocolate sea shells.
- Build a lighthouse stack of biscuits.
- Create an edible rockpool.
- Make some edible sand using crushed digestive biscuits and use it to decorate a seaside themed cake.
- Design your dream stick of rock what new and exciting flavours can you think of?
- Put together a bucket of beach party treats using popcorn, chocolate shells, crushed digestives and savory goldfish snacks.

- Until the 1980s, fish and chips were always wrapped in newspaper. Use newspaper to build a beach hut.
- * Take part in a game of beach bingo.
- Fly a kite. How high can it go and how long does it stay in the air?
- Hide objects on the beach and make a treasure map for another person to hunt for the treasure in the sand.
- A On the beach, dig a hole as deep as you can.
- Create a board game based on the seaside. You could invent a completely new game or adapt one that already exists.
- Challenge your family or friends to a game of pictionary by drawing in the sand. You could also play by sculpting the object instead of drawing it.
- Play a game of Seaside Beetle Drive. Why not use our free resource to get you started?
- 🗚 Pretend you are crabs and take part in a crab walking relay race.
- Beach volleyball is said to have originated in 1915 and is still a firm favourite with holiday makers. Have a game of beach volleyball.
- Visit a seaside arcade and play some games.

Did you know?

The first recognisable coin pusher arcade game was introduced by Alfred Crompton Ltd in 1964 and was called *Penny Falls*. It is still one of the most popular arcade games to this day.

- Tug of War is said to have aged back over 5,000 year ago but is still a firm favourite amongst families at seaside holiday camps. Put together a team and have a game.
- Go head to head at a game of tic tac toe but using painted sea shells instead of counters.
- Write an A-Z list of things on the beach that begin with each letter.
- * How many seaside things can you list in 60 seconds?



- Research the history of donkeys at the seaside. You could even visit a donkey sanctuary or start a fundraiser for donkey welfare.
- Enjoy a seaside holiday made popular by The Royal Family in the 1700s.
- Sing along to the song "Oh I do like to be beside the seaside".
- 🧚 Take a trip to Blackpool Illuminations.
- Find some different kinds of shells and spend some time researching to identify their names, and which animals they came from. You could look online or find a book at the library about shells.
- Entertain your friends or family by putting on your very own variety show similar to those at seaside holiday camps such as Butlin's.
- Put on your own puppet show.

Why?

In May 1662, Punch and Judy, a traditional puppet show, was first introduced in England and has been a popular feature of entertainment for many years, especially at the seaside. Have you ever seen one at the seaside?

- Fundraise for the Royal National Lifeboat Institution (RNLI) to help keep the coastline safe and save lives at sea.
- Complete some lifeguard training.
- Go rockpooling and discover some new creatures.
- Clean up your nearest beach.
- Mean Discover different coloured sands from around the world.
- Go crabbing and see how many crabs you can catch. Remember to put the crabs back in the sea before you head home.
- Write a postcard to a family member or friend as if you were on a seaside holiday. Tell them all about what you have done on your holiday you could include the activities you have taken part in, the food you have eaten and the games you have played on the beach!
- Visit one of the six lighthouses that are open to the public in the UK.
