**PAWPRINT
BADGES**

-  Stonehenge is possibly the most iconic landmark in England and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site; have a go at building your own model.
-  England is known for its wet weather, decorate an umbrella.
-  Build a famous landmark from England such as Big Ben, Blackpool Tower, Brighton Pier, Eden Project or Angel of the North using materials of your choice.
-  Cream teas and afternoon teas are quintessentially English; have a go at drilling a set of plates and make your own afternoon tea stand. You can buy the fittings online and you could rescue a set of plates from a charity shop!
-  The legend of St. George and the Dragon tells of the dragon forcing the villagers to sacrifice livestock and trinkets to satisfy him; make your own trinkets and make jewellery or something shiny.



Food

-  Taste dragon fruit; does it taste how you expected? What did you think it would look like when you cut in to it? Does it deserve its name?
-  Dragons are omnivores and eat both plants and animals, including elephants, tigers, livestock, goats and even family pets! Make a dish using goat meat such as a curry. What did it taste like?
-  Bearded dragons eat insects; try some edible insects yourself.
-  Have a go at making one of these traditional dishes that are less commonly known; Bedfordshire clanger, stottie cake or Snowdon pudding.
-  Use food packaging and make a suit of armour for one of your teddies.
-  Bangers/sausages are a favourite in England (and at Pawprint HQ!) with Cumberland ranking as the number 1! Have a go at making your own.

- England is famous for its pubs and inns which in turn are well known for their traditional pub games. Play a game of one of the following:
Marbles
Dominoes
Backgammon
- Ring the bull was a common game across England. Played with a ring on a string that was tied to the ceiling, players take turns to throw the ring over a horn on the wall. Nowadays hooks are used instead of horns; have a go!
- Take turns to throw a penny in to a hole in a game of Pitch Penny.
- Make your own set of Skittles (also known as Nine Pins) and have a game.
- Wimbledon is one of England's most famous sporting events; have a game of tennis with friends/family or learn some new tennis skills.



Other

- Knights in the Middle Ages were paid 2-4 shillings per day (that's the equivalent of £80-150 today) and London today brings in one quarter of England's wealth. Learn to earn and save money by doing chores.
- London is England's capital city. Take it further and visit there, why not complete a Pawprint Trail on your visit?
- Research which scone topping is more popular in your community ; cream then jam (as in Devon) or jam and then cream (as in Cornwall).
- St. George is famed for taming and slaying a dragon. Watch the film *How to Train Your Dragon* or read Cressida Cowell's books that inspired the film.
- Read *Zog* by Julia Donaldson and discover what dragons learn in school.
- Discover how St. George is depicted around the world.
