

Stocking Beetle Drive

You will need:



1. A copy of this sheet per group.
2. A pencil each and coloured pencils/pens.
3. Plain paper or a copy of the 'My Stocking' sheet (see page 2); one per person.
4. Dice: 1 per group. We recommend groups of no more than 4.

To play:

1. Take it in turns to roll the dice.
2. Roll a 6 to start. Draw your stocking outline on paper or collect your 'My Stocking' sheet.
3. The winner is the first person to complete their stocking. Draw the stocking and decorations as you collect them.


Hints and tips:

- Colour your stocking in lightly so that you can add your pattern over the top.
- Write the name on the top section of your stocking to give more room for other decorations.
- Draw the Christmas animal anywhere you like on your stocking!
- Add the 'decoration' to the top edge of your stocking, like it's hanging from the stocking.
