

Summer Sun Catchers


A colourful craft activity to fill your room with lots of colour! Follow the instructions to make your own stained glass sun catcher to hang in your window this summer.

What You Need:


- Scissors
- Sticky back plastic or a laminator
- Colourful tissue paper
- Glitter or sequins (optional)
- String or ribbon to hang your decoration (optional)

Method:

1. Cut around the outside edge of the black shape; then cut out the white part from inside.
2. Stick the black side face down on a square of sticky back plastic, or lay in a laminating pouch.
3. Tear or cut small pieces of tissue paper and stick them in the 'window' area. Why not add some glitter or sequins at this stage too?
4. Seal your design by sticking another square of sticky back plastic on top, or close your laminating pouch and run it through the machine.
5. Trim your plastic closer to your black outline, but be careful not to cut through it to break the seal.
6. For a hanging decoration, poke a hole in the top and thread some string through.
