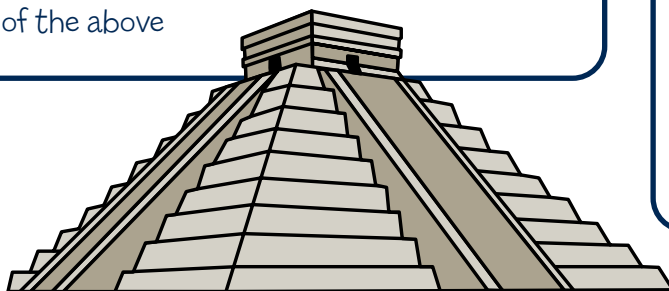


You Will Need:

- Water
- 1 green chilli pepper
- 60g cocoa powder
- 2sp vanilla extract

Instructions:

Add 350ml of water to a saucepan and heat until it starts to boil. Add one green chilli pepper, including the seeds to the water and let it cook for around 5 to 10 minutes. Once the time is up, strain the chilli and seeds out of the water and keep the water in the pot. Pour around 900ml of water into the pot (over the top of the chilli infused water) and leave to boil again. Stir in 60g of cocoa powder and 2sp of vanilla extract. Keep stirring until the cocoa powder is all mixed in and looks smooth. Leave to cool before drinking.

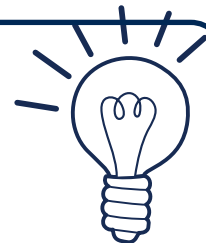
