

You will need:

- Printer
- Thin card or cereal box
- · Plain/coloured papers or card
- Scissors
- · Colouring pens/paint
- · Glue/double sided tape
- Hot melt glue gun (optional)
- Natural materials (optional)
- Embellishments (pompoms, sequins, buttons, etc.)

Grown-Ups:

Use the templates in this resource to colour in or paint (perfect for little hands). Or if you're short on time/looking for a less-messy alternative, print the templates on to different coloured green papers and cards for a ready to go wreath.

Add another level of challenge by curling and manipulating the edges of each leaf to make them more 3-Dimensional.

Instructions:

To make your wreath:

- 1. Create your base by drawing a large circle on to your flattened cereal box, a dinner plate works well (or a side plate for a smaller wreath). Draw a smaller circle inside the larger and cut out the central hole to create a doughnut.
- 2. Print the following pages on to plain paper or thin card if colouring in/painting. Alternatively, print on to green papers and cards.
- 3. Colour/paint your leaves with different shades of green and cut out.
- 4. Arrange your leaves around your base and glue in to place.
- 5. Add any embellishments such as pompoms, buttons, sequins etc. to represent berries, baubles and other decorations.
- 6. Add your natural materials, i.e. pinecones, if using.
- 7. Admire your completed wreath and hang in pride of place.

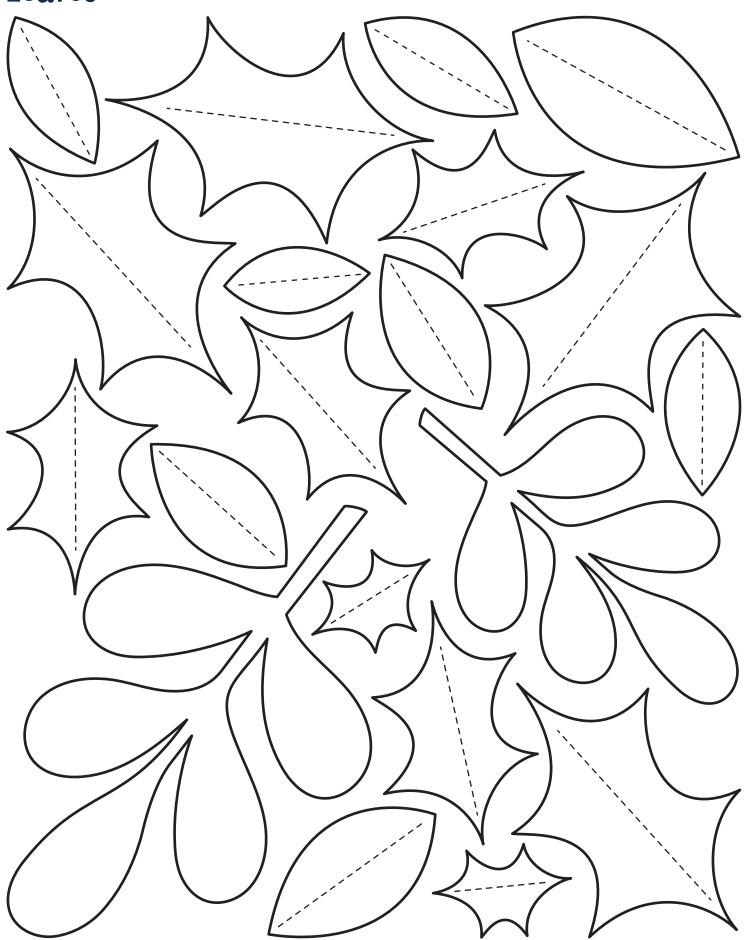
