# **Resource** Recycling Badges: Plastic Free Snap

## You will need:

PAWPRINT

**BADGES** 

- Snap card templates (see following pages)
- Printer
- Paper/Card (old cereal boxes will do)
- Laminator (optional)

# To Make Your Cards:

- 1. Print your snap cards of choice on to plain paper or thin card.
- 2. Stick the templates on to old cereal boxes to strengthen OR laminate the cards so they can be reused time and time again.
- 3. Cut out the cards along the dotted lines. You're ready to play!

#### Instructions:

All ages should discuss plastic free/eco swaps, why we should make them and what type of alternatives there are. The alternatives given here are not exhaustive.

- Shuffle the cards and deal them out evenly between players. Placing the last card, face up, in the centre.
- Take it in turns to place a card, face up, on top of the pile. When you spot a pair, place your hand on top of the pile in the middle and shout 'SNAP!'
- The player who claims all the cards wins.


#### Easy Cards:

- Snap = 2 identical cards showing the original and the eco-friendly swap. **Hard Cards:**
- Snap = an 'normal' item PLUS its eco-friendly version/swap.


#### Alternative play:

- Use the 'HARD' cards to play pairs. Give each person in the group one card.
- Without talking and not showing anyone your card, find your pair.




