


Wild West Boots (page 2)


Challenge yourself to design a repeating pattern on your Wild West boots. Use the design square below and the instructions on the right to create a repeating pattern that you can trace onto your boots.



Still not sure? Check out the 'how to' video on our 'Wild West' Pinterest board for help.

How to create a repeating pattern:

- 1. Draw part of your design in the centre of the square, not touching the outside edges.
- 2. Keeping the squares upright, cut out the square and down the dashed lines so that you have 4 individual pattern squares.
- 3. Swap squares 1 and 4, and swap 2 and 3, being careful not to rotate the squares.
- 4. Tape all 4 squares together on the back.
- 5. Draw the rest of your design across the blank centre made by your 4 squares.
- 6. Now put your design under your boots template and trace over the top!





Scan your pattern square into your computer and use digital software to create your own repeating desktop background!

You don't have to draw your repeated pattern if you don't want to... Why not print using potato printing or sponge paint your pattern instead?
