






# **HOW TO:**Use Your Expansion Pack

## PAWPRINT \*\*BADGES

- Can you imagine sprouting wings like Lenny in *The Boy with Wings*, by Lenny Henry?! You don't have to imagine! Use paper, card, feathers or any craft material of your choice to make a set of your very own wings!

- 'If you got hungry, what would you eat?'... Use Pippa Goodhart's story *You Choose* to plan out and make a fantastic food feast for you and a friend, featuring only the foods you want to eat.

# Games



- Create your own book character trump cards. Download the free Character Trump Cards resource from our website to start trumping (not literally...)
