




Christmas tree climbing.



From junk modelling to crochet or even origami, the choice is yours to make!




Edible festivities.

From stained glass window biscuits to hang on the tree, to a sleigh built from chocolate bars and sweets, or even a candy cane bouquet, what will you choose?









Alternatively, write some Christmas cards and send some festive post to your friends and family. Why not try our Christmas Post Challenge too?




Cut paper snowflakes.

Have a go at creating your own symmetrical snowflakes by folding and cutting paper. Find a template online at: pawprintfamily.com/badgevent


Why not collect all of your little offcuts and repurpose them as confetti like the grumpy elf?




Edible fairy lights.

Just like a traditional beetle drive but with snowmen!


Roll the dice and gather your body parts to build your snowman. Use our free resource to help. If you have snow outside, you could even build your snowman for real!
