




HOW TO: Use Your Challenge Pack

PAWPRINT **BADGES

- Capricorn means 'goat horned'. Craft your own goat horns.
- Realistic thinking is a key trait of Capricorns. Challenge yourself to complete a realistic painting or drawing.
- Make a gift for a friend. Capricorns like to make others happy.
- Capricorns are incredibly resourceful so upcycle something that you were going to throw away. Why not make your own Capricornus goat-fish out of junk model materials?

What?

The Capricornus constellation is usually represented as a goat with a fish tail. One common interpretation comes from the Greek myth of Pan who jumped into the water to avoid Typhon. However, he was changing into animal form at the same time so the top half became a goat and the bottom half became a fish.

- Knit or crochet your own Capricornus representation with a goat's head and front legs but a fish tail.
- Paint a picture of the Capricornus constellation.
- Collage two animals together like artist Arne Olav Gurvin Fredriksen. Capricornus is a goat-fish mashup but which animals' body parts will you choose to combine? What name will you give your creation?
- The birth flower of Capricorns is the pansy. Have a go at making your own pansy from paper, felt or yarn.
- Make some pansy wrapping paper and wrap a birthday present for a friend who is a Capricorn.

How?

Start with a large sheet of paper or some plain wrapping paper. Print with a potato stamp or use a paintbrush to create a pansy pattern. For an extra challenge, why not try hammering some real pansies to create a natural pattern?

- Draw a pansy. Have a look online or in the library if you need help starting.
- Make your own fishtail friendship bracelet from embroidery thread, yarn or small rubber bands.
- Learn how to make a fishtail braid in your hair or a friend's.

1 Food



- There is a big kid inside every Capricorn'. Enjoy some sweeties.
- Capricorns are resourceful. Put together a meal with ingredients that you already have in your cupboards.
- Which food is your GOAT (Greatest Of All Time)? Capricorn is represented as a goat-fish.
- Plan a meal with lots of calcium and protein to keep your body strong like a Capricorn. Remember to have a healthy balanced diet too.
- Prepare some festive food.

Why?

Christmas, Kwanzaa and New Year take place under the Capricorn zodiac. The dates of Hanukkah and Winter Solstice vary but they are sometimes under Capricorn too.

- Capricorns are often described as self-reliant. Cook yourself a meal.
- Follow one of famous Capricorn chef Rick Stein's recipes.
- The colours of Capricorn are brown and grey because they are practical and reliable. Prepare yourself some brown food such as by baking a reliable chocolate cake.
- Decorate cupcakes with some edible pansies or violets, the lucky flowers of those born under Capricorn.

Remember!

Pansies and violets are types of viola, but not all viola flowers are edible. Make sure yours are safe for eating before tasting or serving.

- Capricorns like to make others feel happy. Bake some biscuits and deliver them to a neighbour, friend or family member to cheer them up.
- 9-5 singer Dolly Parton is a Capricorn. Choose a day and plan the meals you'll eat from 9am to 5pm.
- Try goat in a curry or stew. What does it taste like? If meat isn't for you, why not try some goat's milk or cheese?
- Enjoy some fish, such as with chips or in a pie. For an extra challenge, learn how to fillet a fish yourself.

© Games

- Capricorns are known for their stability and order. Test your stability in a balancing game such as hopscotch or Jenga®.
- What's your favourite fact? Capricorns love collecting facts so take part in a quiz to test your general knowledge.
- If any zodiac would win the marshmallow test, it would be Capricorn because they are the most disciplined. Can you pass the marshmallow test?

For Leaders!

The marshmallow test teaches children about delayed gratification. Give the child a treat; it doesn't have to be a marshmallow. Explain that you are going to leave the room and they can eat the treat while you are gone, or if they don't they can have two treats when you return. Leave the room and wait a few minutes - the longer you wait, the harder it is for them to resist. Return and give the extra treat if deserved.

- Capricorns find it difficult to share their struggles. Practice sharing the load in a team building game such as capture the flag.
- Rise the ranks like a Capricorn on the career ladder in a climbing or a Jacob's ladder adventurous activity. Alternatively, why not play a game of ladders?
- Looking for facts and evidence before jumping to conclusions, Capricorns make really good detectives. Take part in an escape room style activity.
- Similarly, Capricorns enjoy puzzles and games that are absorbing and complicated. Have a go at some brain teasers.
- Trust is a key trait of Capricorns. Challenge your friends in a trust circle.

How?

In groups of at least four, arrange chairs in a circle facing inwards. Each person sits on a chair facing the person on their left (or right but all the same). Lean back so each person's head is resting on the next person's knees. When everyone's comfortable, remove the chairs and you should be left with a self-supporting ring of people. Alternatively, try standing in a circle facing the back of the person next to you. 3, 2, 1, sit down!

- Pay attention while you play Simon Says, musical statues or a Kim's game. Capricorns pay 100% attention to everything they do.
- Where land meets water, Capricornus is half goat and half fish. Have a game of newspaper islands or cross the river.

Other



- Visit some goats at a local farm.
- Capricorns are confident that they can achieve anything. Try a new skill or practice something that you'd like to get better at.
- A problem shared is a problem halved but Capricorns find it hard to share their struggles. Talk to a friend or family member about something that is playing on your mind. Maybe you can come up with a solution together?
- The Princess of Wales is a Capricorn and does lots of charity work, especially surrounding children and mental health. Raise money for a local charity.
- Kensington Palace is the official residence of the Princess of Wales. Why not take a trip and complete our Kensington Gardens Trail while you're there?
- Capricorns are the hardest workers. Set yourself a challenge and work hard to achieve your goal.
- Read a book to collect facts and knowledge like a Capricorn.
- Have a go at gardening or some DIY. Capricorns enjoy spending time at home and being practical.
- Try stargazing to spot Capricornus. This is a tricky constellation to see because its stars are not very bright, but it is best seen in the Northern Hemisphere around 9pm in mid-September.
- Capricorns are disciplined with their spending and often use money as a measure of success. Budget for an activity with your friends, family or group.
- Have a go at being an Agony Aunt because Capricorns are known for their amazing advice. Why not borrow *Dear Mother Goose* or *Dear Fairy Godmother* by Michael Rosen and Nick Sharratt from your local library?
- There is a big kid inside every Capricorn. Take a trip to your local sweet shop.
- Make a to-do list and 'get stuff done' like a Capricorn.
- Pansies are the birth flowers of Capricorns. Grow or plant some of your own.
- A Capricorn's mood can change in the blink of an eye. Read *Stompysaurus* by Rachel Bright to learn about your emotions and how to control them.
- Have a go at blowing a conch shell like Pan in the Capricornus mythology.
