
Leapfrog Draughts Game

Cut out the two armies of frogs on page 2 and use them to hop over your opponent in a game of draughts on the lily pond below.





Each player has an army of 12 frogs that hop across the pond!

The darker frogs will hop across from the left to the right, and the lighter frogs will hop from the right to the left.



Leapfrog Draughts Game - Page 2

Cut out the two armies of frogs and use them to hop over your opponent in a game of draughts on the lily pond on page 1.



How To Play

- 1. Start by choosing who will have which army of frogs.
- 2. Then, each player pops one frog on each of the 12 lily pads closest to them (3 rows).
- 3. Frogs can only hop diagonally to adjacent lily pads and there can only be one frog on each lily pad. If there is an opponent's frog on that lily pad and the next lily pad in the same direction is free, you can 'leapfrog' and capture your opponent's frog. If it's possible to leapfrog again (in either direction), you can keep going within the same turn.
- 4. The aim of the game is to get your frogs to the other side of the pond.
- 5. The army who has the most frogs hop across the pond without being captured is the winner!

Cut out the two armies of frogs above and use as your game counters!
