# PAWPRINT FAMILY FAMILY Resource Illuminated Dragon Lanterns

Your lantern could look like this when you're done!

### You will need:

- 1 jam jar (empty and clean)
- Coloured tissue paper
- PVA glue
- Paint brush/glue spreader
- Scissors or a craft knife
- Newspaper/cutting mat
- Dragon shape(s) (see following pages)
- T-light/small candle

### Ages 3-7:

Using scissors, cut out some of the shapes on page 1 and stick them on your jar.

#### Ages 7-14:

Have a go at cutting out your shapes independently using a craft knife.

#### Ages 14-18+:

Cut out shapes using a craft knife or have a go at creating your own face shapes for a truly unique lantern.

## Instructions:

- 1. Cover the table with a cutting mat or newspaper.
- 2. Tear/cut your tissue paper into small pieces about 2cm square.
- 3. Stick your tissue paper onto your jam jar, covering the whole thing. Make sure there are no holes/gaps in your tissue paper layer. You could mix your colours or use one colour across the whole jar.
- 4. Choose which dragon shape(s) you are going to use from the following pages.
- 5. Cut out your shape(s) using scissors or a craft knife. For the smallest adventurers cut out a selection of shapes for them to choose from.
- 6. Stick your shape(s) onto your jam jar with a thin layer of PVA glue, over the top of your tissue paper.
- 7. Allow to dry.
- 8. Place candle inside jar and light. Alternatively, why not add some fairy lights?
