Craft

-  Create daffodil paper bunting. Head to our 'St. David's Day' Pinterest board for instructions on how to make yours.
-  Make a daffodil brooch out of felt to wear on St. David's Day.
-  Put together your own het Gymreig - a tall hat traditionally worn by women as part of the Welsh national costume.
-  Construct your own version of St. David's Cathedral out of craft/building materials of your choice. You could even make it out of biscuits!
-  Some people believe that St. David went on a special religious journey to Jerusalem and brought back a stone. Decorate a set of St. David's Day stones that you can display in your home every year.
-  We only really see St. David represented in stained glass windows and paintings. Design your own St David's day stained glass window.








Food

-  St. David and his monks were vegetarians. Whip up a vegetarian dish to enjoy with family or serve up at a celebration feast.
-  Make a meal using leeks. St. David himself was said to only consume leeks and water, which may be why the Welsh symbol is a leek!
-  Cook up a Welsh recipe of your choice. Will you cook a well-loved classic or take your own twist on a traditional recipe?
-  Bake some Mango Daffodil Meringues. Find the recipe on our 'St. David's Day' Pinterest board.
-  Use up your leeks to make a cheesy Baked Potato Leek Frittata. Not only does it use leeks inspired by St. David, it's a vegetarian recipe too! Swap out the cheese to make this a vegan recipe.
-  Have a go at making a Welsh Onion Cake. Find a recipe of your choice online.









Games

-  Name the welsh delicacy. Place pictures of traditional Welsh dishes into a Welsh hat and take it in turns to pick a picture out. You get a point if you can guess the dish correctly (extra points if you can say it in Welsh!)
-  Put together your own St. David's Day/Welsh quiz and hold a quiz night with friends and family on 1st March to celebrate. Why not use some of the tasty dishes you make for your food activities to impress your guests?
-  Play a game of Simon says but this time do what St. David says instead.
-  Take part in a Welsh colour hunt! Race to find 10 objects that are red, 10 that are green and 10 that are white. Bonus points if you can find an object that is all three colours. Make the game even more challenging by adding a time limit for each colour (e.g. 2 minutes).
-  Whilst out and about on St. David's Day, keep count of how many daffodils, leeks and dragons you see. Why not keep a tally chart?



Other

-  Visit St. David's Cathedral in Pembrokeshire, Wales to see the shrine of St. David. After it was destroyed in a fire and raided by Vikings in 645, the shrine was restored in 2012 and is a focus for prayer by many people.
-  Write your own St. David's Day poem. Why not use some of his well-known sayings and quotes?
-  St. David was said to be a powerful speaker. Think about what you would say to your followers if you were St. David. Write down an inspirational quote or speech to inspire your fellow people.
-  Learn the Welsh national anthem.
-  Take part in a St. David's Day parade or enjoy watching one instead. Why not wear a traditional Welsh costume for the event?
-  Celebrate St. David's day by dancing your heart out to a classic Welsh tune.
