You Will Need:

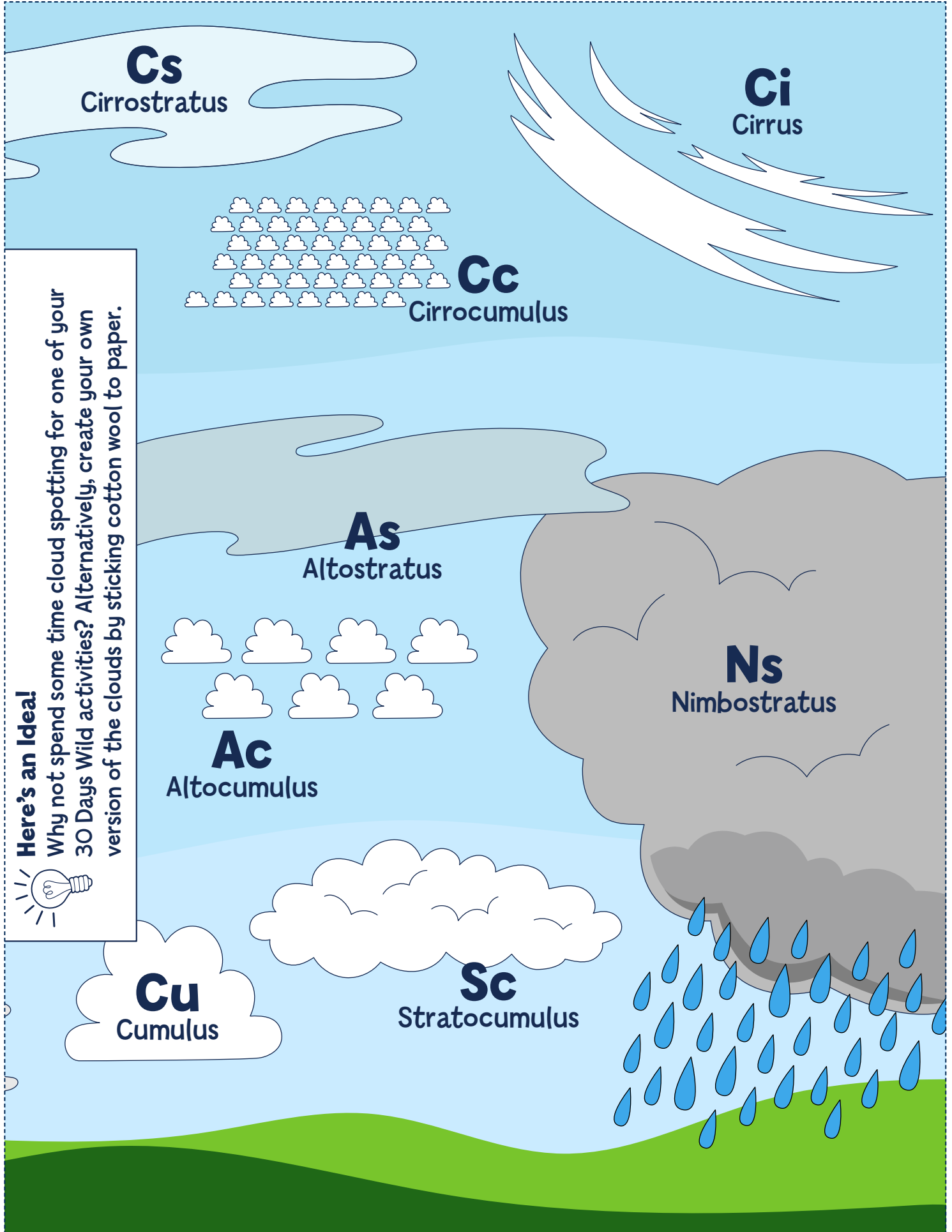
- A copy of this resource
- Cardboard (A3 in size)
- Glue or double sided tape
- Scissors
- Craft knife (optional)

To Make Your Window:

1. Cut out the cloud identification image from both pages, cutting along the dashed line.
2. Glue along the shaded area down the right hand side.
3. Stick page 2 over the top along the solid hairline to create one large image.
4. Stick the whole image on to your cardboard.
5. Cut out and remove the viewing window (this area) using your craft knife.
6. Head outside and see if you can identify some clouds!
