

What do you like to top your porridge with? Try some different varitions.




### Decorate a tree.

Make a festive tree decoration, or have a go at crafting your own Christmas tree.








#### Festive Fireworks.

Discover how fireworks get their different colours. Did you know this badge glows in the dark?








#### Sinterklaas.
