1. Peace Apple.

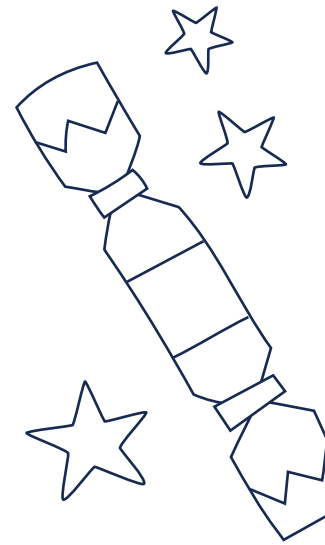

3. Decorate a tree.

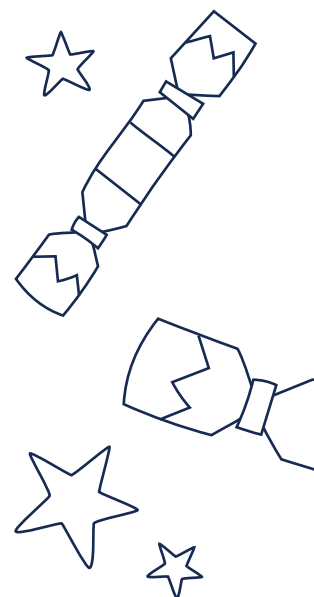
Frohe Weihnachten!

4. Festive Fireworks.

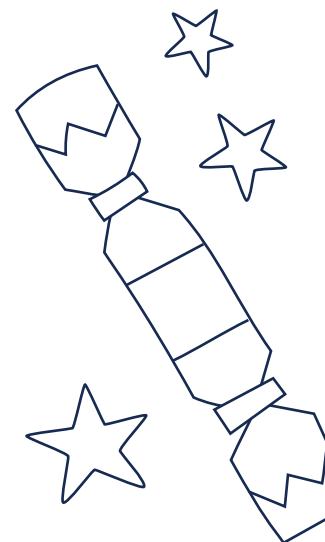

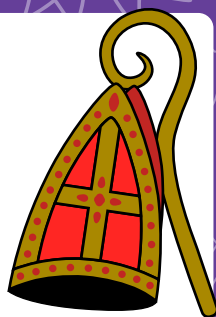

5. Sinterklaas.

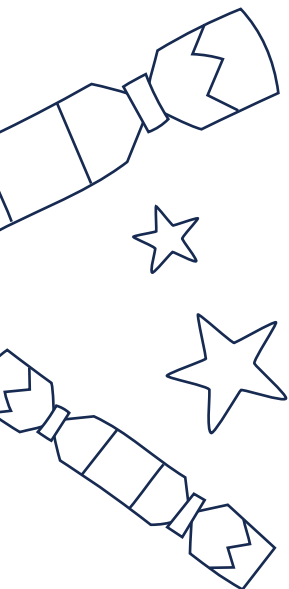

6. Spread some cheer.

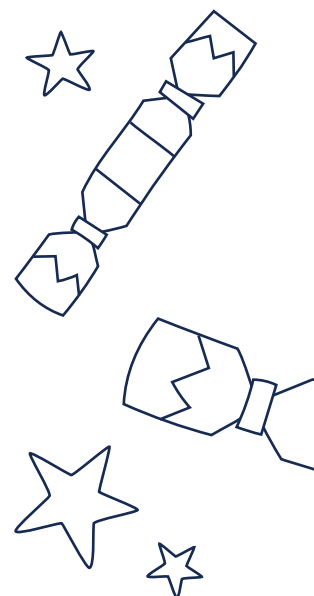
Щасливиx Свят! The Ukranian legend of the Christmas spider is said to be the origin of tinsel on Christmas trees.

7. Colourful Christmas.

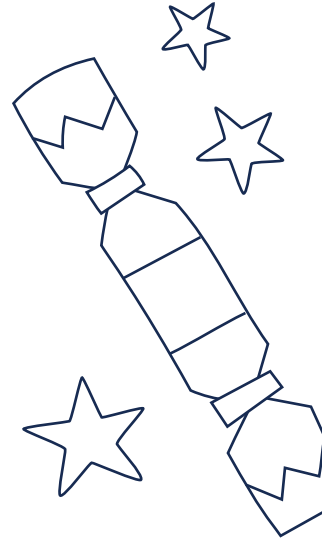
Maligayang Pasko! The most popular Christmas decoration in The Philippines is a parol lantern.

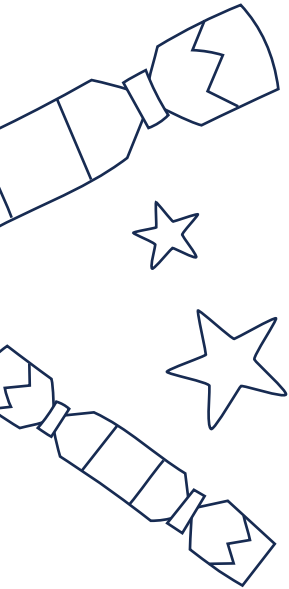
8. Festive Food.

9. Share the love.

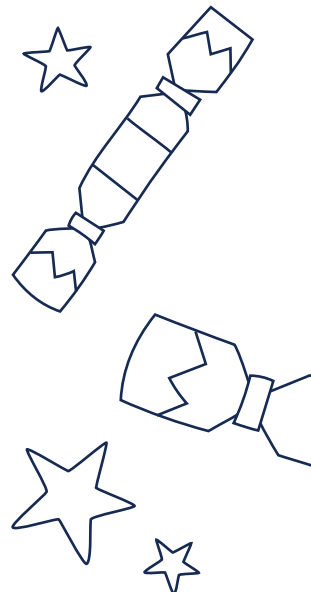
Wesołych Świąt! On Christmas Eve, Polish families share Oplatek wafers and give each other blessings for the year ahead.

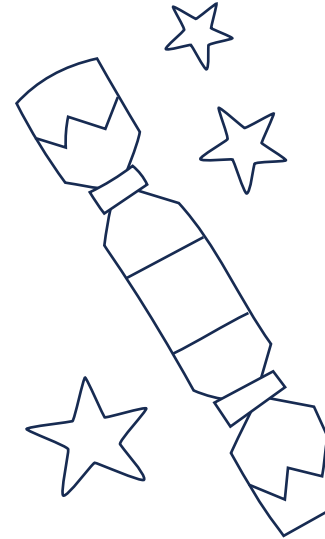
10. Mele Kalikimaka!

11. Christmas Cricket.

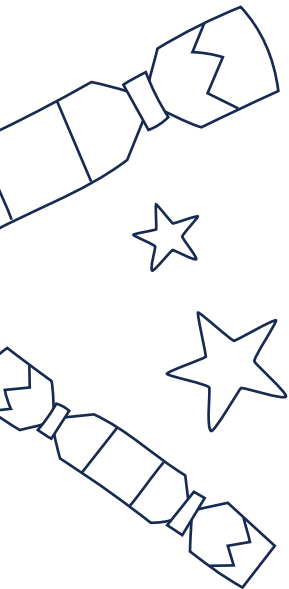
Geseënde Kersfees! It's summer in the Southern Hemisphere. South African families often play cricket after their sunny Christmas dinner.
