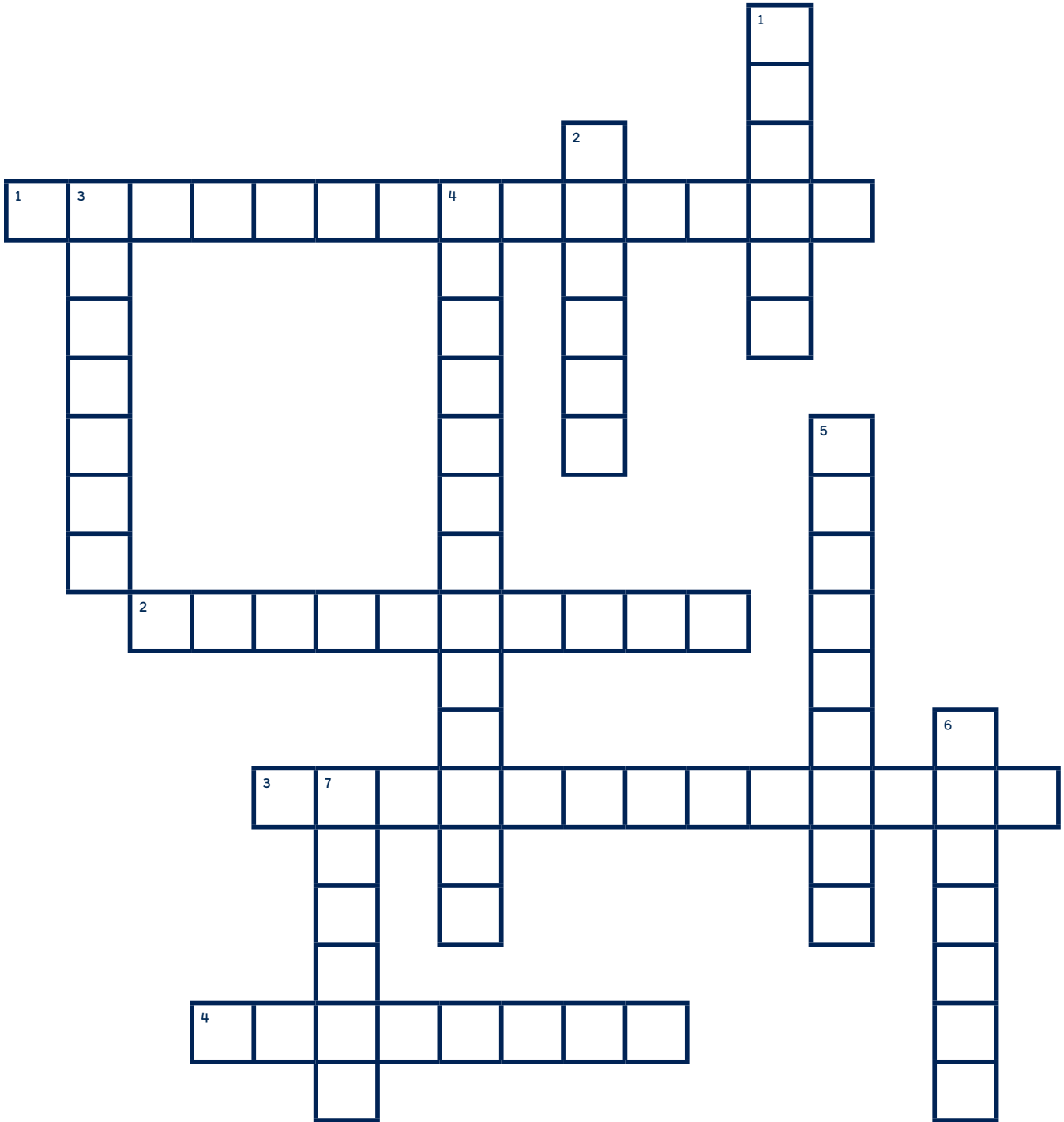


Crossword

4. Smooth and shiny as a result of being rubbed.

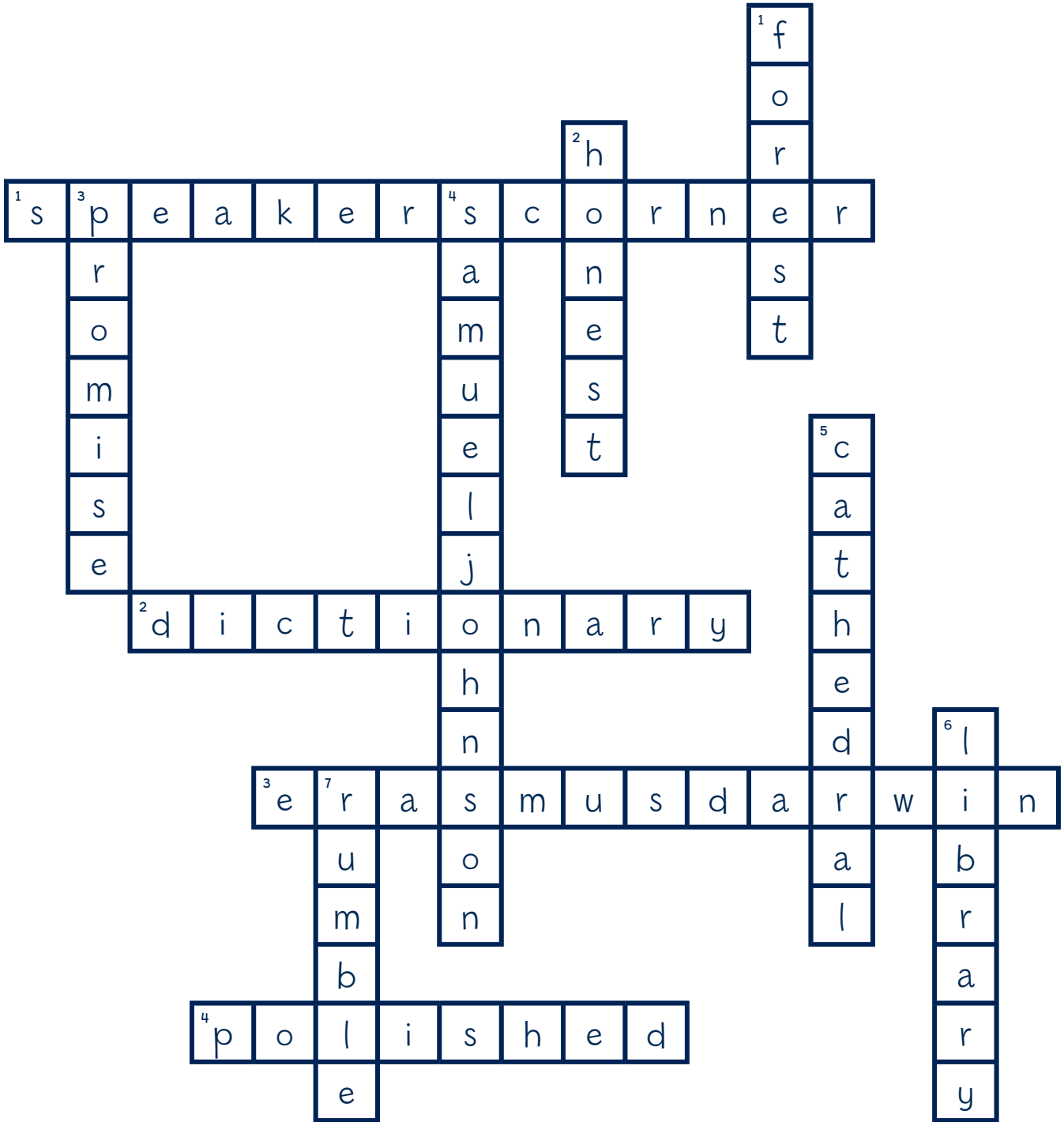
